We will visit Krinides (or Crenides), an area that includes the archaeological site of Philippi in the Kavala Prefecture. The area of Krinides was well known from the era of the early Macedonian Kings for its fertile soil and thermal water. It was also in Philippi that Paul met with a woman named Lydia, a purple-dye merchant who became the first Christian convert Celebrate Mass at the special site where Lydia was baptized Return to Thessaloniki for evening dinner and overnight

This morning we will visit the Agora and Church of St. Demetrius constructed on the site of an ancient Roman bath. Also visit the Arch of

Continue through Berea (Veria) to see Paul's Berna where both he and Silas preached to a Jewish settlement after leaving the Thessalonians and celebrate

Visit Vergina, home of the burial site of the kings of Macedon, including the tomb of Philip II, father of Alexander the Great. Continue to Kalambaka
